In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Bombay Village Panchayats Act, 1958, the Government of Maharashtra hereby directs that where villages have been divided into wards on the basis of the 1961 census figures before commencement of the Bombay Village Panchayats (Amendment) Act, 1965 viz. 1-10-65, the Collectors ~~xxx~~ shall not for the purposes of elections to village panchayats to be held hereafter divide them again in the manner prescribed in clause (a) of rule 3 of the Bombay Village Panchayats (Divisions of Village into Wards and Reservation of Seats for Women, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Rules, 1966.
