CIRCULAR:- Although the powers of Government under section 4(2) of the Bombay Village Panchayats Act, 1953 have been delegated to the Divisional Commissioners in regard to the splitting up of Village Panchayats, they are required to submit cases which are proposed to be rejected by them, for approval of Government before final orders are passed. Government has considered the question whether it is necessary for the Divisional Commissioners to submit such proposals to Government and is pleased to direct that there is no necessity for the Divisional Commissioners to submit cases to Government which are proposed to be rejected by them. The Commissioners of Divisions are accordingly requested to discontinue forthwith the submission of such proposals to Government.
